

2018 LMMS Band/Chorus/Orchestra Spring Trip

Miscellaneous Information

The LMMS Music Staff strongly believes in keeping this trip cost effective for our families, but safety and health are also a priority. We have made the decision to travel home on Sunday morning, arriving at LMMS early on Sunday afternoon around 6 p.m.

ROOMS – Four students are assigned to each room with 2 beds in each room. For the most part, students are allowed able to choose their roommates. Chaperones rooms are next door or across the hall to their group.

DOUBLERS – Students who are involved in 2 of our music programs will be asked to only perform/workshop with 1 of their groups with the priority being on the chorus and/or orchestra performance. If they choose to workshop with their 2nd group, we are happy to accommodate that request as long as it logistically works out with the itinerary – just remember that it takes time away from your park time!

STUDENT GROUPS – This trip is designed for 1 chaperone per 8 students. When walking around the parks – a minimum of 4 students MUST be together at all times.

FOOD ALLERGIES - We will do all we can to make accommodation's for our students with food allergies, if you let us know ahead of time. Please email your director.

NO HEALTH INSURANCE – If your family does not have health insurance during the time of the trip, please fill out the student's name on the medical form and notate NO HEALTH INSURANCE. CCSD does offer student accident insurance from the Young Group if you are interested – but this is not mandatory. Email your director if you need a form.

CHAPERONES – If you are interested in chaperoning the trip, please let us know on the attached form. Chaperones that are selected will be notified in January. **PLEASE DO NOT PAY MONEY UNTIL YOU HAVE BEEN SELECTED. The full amount of \$325 must be paid by Monday, March 26, 2018.** Two chaperones are assigned to a room. Chaperones have the option to pay an extra \$110 to have a room alone. There will be a mandatory chaperone meeting in April to discuss specific details of the trip and of the role of the chaperone. We need male and female chaperones!

SPECIAL CONCERNS – If your student has any special concerns of any kind, please talk to us! Don't guess how we will respond. Let's make this a pleasant experience for all!

ACCOMPANYING FAMILIES – If you wish to take your family to Disney at the same time, then you are welcome to make your own travel arrangements to/from Walt Disney World. Once the itinerary is set, we will be happy to give you a copy so that you can be in the same park with us. Families are not able to go to the workshop with the students, but all are welcome at Downtown Disney for the chorus and orchestra performances! We eat breakfast each day as a school group either at the hotel or out at a restaurant. This does not include families, so families should plan on meeting us in the park each day.
